- Complete all relevant paper work regarding your duties e.g. Daily register, Task Briefs, COSS sheets, Allocation sheets, Safety Briefs, and Timesheets etc. are correctly completed and handed in on time.
- All Plant, Vehicles & equipment kept in good order and not damaged.
- All damaged and stolen plant to be reported immediately to Foreman / Site Manager Project Manager along with explanation of damage/theft.
- Ensure actual hours worked only are recorded on time sheets.
- Driving Company vehicles in a safe, legal and courteous manner at all times.
- Correct PPE worn at all times, i.e. all orange Hi vis / Hard hat / Boots / Gloves / Light Eye protection and other PPE as required depending on the nature of the work.

This role involves shift working that will include days, nights and weekend work. When working on the Rail Infrastructure no alcohol or drug consumption is permitted and there will be regular drug and alcohol testing and a pre-employment medical check. If you're shortlisted for this position, there'll also be a communications test. You should be conscientious, reliable and hard working,



making sure you only carry out work for which you're trained and competent. The health and safety of all everyone depends on each individual's contribution, so you must always work safely and in accordance with our procedures, method' and other instructions.
